RE: Misprint on WMYSA Player Cards for Fall 2010/Spring 2011 Season

For the Fall 2010 season, some WMYSA player cards were produced incorrectly indicating that they were for the Spring 2010 season. All other information on the card is correct and accurate, including the designated team, age group, and ID#. For those teams that received their cards prior to August 30, their official league roster may also contain the incorrect playing season.

WMYSA is taking the following actions:

- (1) ROSTERS issued with a Spring 2010 date will be replaced promptly prior to the start of the season. League rosters with the incorrect playing season should be discarded immediately upon receiving the corrected roster. The corrected, official league roster should be shown to referees or tournament officials, along with a copy of this letter, if there are any questions about the misprinted player cards.
- (2) Player and coach CARDS issued with a Spring 2010 date will not be reissued until after the Fall 2010 season has ended. These cards will be considered valid during the Fall 2010 season. After the Fall 2010 season has ended, teams that do not have photos entered into GotSoccer will be contacted to make arrangements for returning current cards so that photos can be reused on replacement cards prior to the spring season.
