Dual registrations will not be permitted by MSYSA during the months of May, June, October and November, unless a hardship case exists & approved by MSYSA (MSYSA member organization must enforce this requirement), the following restrictions apply to dual registration:

- The team with which a dual rostered player first registers shall be designated his/her primary team and the other team his/her secondary team.
- A player may not play for more than one (1) team in the same competition (meaning MSYSA sanctioned tournament, MSYSA State Cup, MSYSA member organization league division, etc.). If a team plays in MSPSP and/or MSYSA State Cup the player must be primary on this team.
- If the coaches of the two (2) teams disagree on the designation of the primary team, the player may not play until the issue has been resolved by WMYSA.
- A dual rostered player shall be issued two (2) MSYSA US Youth Soccer passcards, one (1) for each team.
- If a team plays in the MSYSA State Cup then the player must be primary on this team.
- In the case of a player playing on an MSPSP team, the Premier Program team must be his/her primary team. In the case of a player playing on a team in the Midwest Regional League (MRL), the MRL team must be his/her primary team. Thus, a player may not dual register between a MRL team and a MSPSP team.
- Any player who registers for a team without informing the responsible team official and member organization official that they already registered with another team shall forfeit all games for BOTH teams for the time period that the player has not obtained the approved dual registration from from MSYSA member (s).
