Voluntary Release means the removal of a player from a team's roster at the request of the player or parent/guardian. A parent/player must approve the voluntary release but a coach approval is not required.

Voluntary Releases will be granted if:

- A parent/player request to be released.
- The player moves to a new address, a distance which in the opinion of the Board, would make it impractical for him to continue with the original team.
- There are mitigating circumstances, which in the opinion of the Board justify a release.

Involuntary Release means the removal of a player from a team's roster at the request of team authorities. An involuntary release will be granted only if the player is unable to play for one of the following reasons:

- The original team suspends operations for the remainder of the seasonal year or
- The player has violated rules of this Association and has been suspended for a period greater than five (5) games or.
- The player is injured in such a manner that the player will not be able to participate for the remainder of the seasonal year or.
- The player moves to a new address, a distance that in the opinion of the board of directors would make it impractical for him to continue with the original team and has demonstrated an inability to continue in participation on the soccer team.
- There are mitigating circumstances, which in the opinion of the Board justify a release.

Once a player is released from a team he/she is eligible to apply for a player transfer. **However, obtaining a player release does not guarantee the player a roster spot on another MSYSA team.**
