Rules for the Fall 2020 season at the Kingdom Soccer Complex.

- All players, coaches, managers, and spectators are required to follow all State of Michigan Executive Orders and Michigan State Youth Soccer Association Return to Play Guidelines at all times.
- Live audiences for games are limited to 100 people or fewer gathered for the event including all participants (athletes, coaches, staff, etc.) In order to accommodate these limitations, we recommend each athlete be limited to 2 guests.
- Restrooms will be open in the back of the new KIDFIT DAYCARE. There is a door in the middle of the back of the building. Please follow the restroom arrow signs. Hands free sinks and hand dryers are available in these facilities.
- People should not walk through the daycare playground to get to the bathrooms.
