For the Spring 2021 season at Portage Soccer Complex and Practice Facility the following are in force:

- All players, coaches, managers, and spectators are required to follow all State of Michigan Executive Orders and Michigan State Youth Soccer Association Return to Play Guidelines at all times.
- Live audiences for games are limited to 300 people or fewer gathered for the event including all participants (athletes, coaches, staff, etc.). For State Cup, Michigan State Premier Soccer Program, and Director's Academy, spectators shall be limited to 2 persons per player. For all other leagues, we recommend each athlete be limited to 2 guests.
- All concession facilities will be closed for the Spring 2021 season.
- All transportation services will be limited for the Spring 2021 season.
